

Five Year Planning Committee Minutes
Dec 11, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 10:15 by Chair Elaine Brigman. Present were Nora Gray, Jurgen Haedicke and John Steward.

The minutes of the Nov. 21 meeting were reviewed and accepted.

Elaine handed out three submitted mission statements and the committee discussed the relative merits of each.

It was decided, after discussion with input from the floor, that the following would be our Mission Statement

“Mobile Estates is a resident owned 55 plus community located in a prime location near Siesta Key in Sarasota Florida. Our residents work together to provide an inclusive and supportive environment where each can enjoy an individual lifestyle with access to social and healthy communal activities.

It was decided that the committee would prepare a request to all the residents asking for their suggestions on what projects, items or spending requirements that can be undertaken over the next 5 years to make our community sustainable and provide them with amenities and facilities that enhance their preferred lifestyle here at Mobile Estates.

A suggestion box will be set up in the clubhouse so that the suggestions can be forwarded to the committee.
